- BEST WESTERN Auburn/Opelika Inn. 205 N. 21st St., Opelika. (334) 745-6293. The alternate hotel nearest the Marriott, the Best Western is located at the intersection of US-280 and Pepperell Parkway (Opelika Rd). They are holding a block of 10 rooms for July 8-11 at a rate of \$79. The cutoff date is June 24th.
- HAMPTON INN & SUITES 3000 Capps Way, Opelika. (334) 745-4311. Located just off I-85 at Exit 58, this hotel is on the other side of the interstate from Tiger Town and sits next to a large new movie theater. They are holding 5 rooms for July 8-9 and 10 rooms for July 10-11 at a rate of \$114. The cutoff date is June 17th.
- FAIRFIELD INN & SUITES Auburn Opelika. 2257 Interstate Drive, Opelika. (334) 742-2590. This hotel is adjacent to Tiger Town with numerous restaurants and shops within a short walk or drive. They are holding 6 rooms for July 8-11 at a rate of \$109. The cutoff date is July 17th.

The AKAA Board Needs You!


